NEW JERSEY'S STATEWIDE ASSESSMENT PROGRAM

- In 2015, New Jersey adopted the Partnership for Assessment of Readiness for College and Careers (PARCC) to replace HSPA and previous assessments in the elementary and middle school in language arts and mathematics.
- Students took PARCC English Language Arts and Literacy Assessments (ELA/L) in grades 3 11.
- Students took PARCC Mathematics Assessments in grades 3 8 and End of Course Assessments in Algebra I, Geometry, and Algebra II.

PARCC Changes in the 2015-16 School Year

Based upon feedback from a variety of stakeholders...

- *Reduced testing time for students
- *Reduced number of units for all students
- *One testing window

Testing Units

Grade 3-5

- 4 Math Units over 2 days (no calculator)
- 3 ELA Units

Grades 6-8

- 3 Math Units (1 non-calculator/active, 2 calculator)
- 3 ELA Units



Time Testing v. Administration Time

Test time = Actual time students are permitted to test.

Administration time = Test time + material distribution + reading of directions + log-in/out + break (if testing more than one unit (gr. 3-5))

Task	Administration Time
Pre-administration tasks, including reading instructions to students and answering questions	10 minutes
2. Distribution of test materials to students	5 minutes
3. Administration of unit	Refer to Unit Testing Times below (60–110 minutes)
End-of-unit activities, including logging students out of TestNav and collecting test materials	5–15 minutes
