- Increase of $7^{\text {th }} \& 8^{\text {th }}$ grade students exceeding expectations!
- $42 \%$ Exceeded expectations in last year's $8^{\text {th }}$ grade class in ELA.
- 82\% of Algebra I students MET or EXCEEDED expectations.
- 78\% of Grade 8 ELA students MET or EXCEEDED expectations.
- Cohort of same students, consecutive grades show growth over time throughout middle school.
