Dear Parents and Guardians,

The Allamuchy Township School District has been closely monitoring the data released through the Warren County Health Department. Since the week of Thanksgiving, our Region has been in the Orange Health Risk category. As a precaution, the Allamuchy Township School District decided to pivot to remote learning for the two weeks after Thanksgiving for most classes.

December 14, our expected return to the hybrid schedule date, is quickly approaching, and we wanted to provide you with an update to our plans. Over the past week, we have been alerted of a few instances where members of our school community have been listed as contacts and have been placed on quarantine. Additionally, our status of high risk has remained in the high risk category but is steadily increasing. This information has made us realize that we will not be able to successfully operate our hybrid schedule at this time.

With this new information, we will continue with the virtual programming that we have had in place during these two weeks. Additionally, as of December 14, we will pivot to 100% remote learning for our few select programs that we are currently running. We will continue with this format through January 15, 2021. We will monitor the health status of our school community throughout this time and update you with any new information that is presented to us in a timely

manner. We expect to provide you with the schedule and plan for Jan. 19, 2021 as we get closer to that date.

Important increased health and safety monitorings and procedures due to the Orange Health Risk status:

• You must monitor your child's health more closely. If your child displays *any* covid symptoms, please call the school nurse.
