Risks can be both positive and negative. What is a positive risk?

Negative risks can be hurtful to your health and safety (and the health and safety of others). **Positive risks** can benefit us and others, it can also help us explore life and experiences beyond our comfort zone.

Examples:

- Trying a more accelerated class in school
- Participating in a new sport or activity
- Learning a new language
- Getting to know classmates beyond your "friend circle"
