“Week of Respect” is a state mandated week that all schools are required to observe in the first full week of October. This year's “ Week of Respect” will be observed from October 3th through 7th. Our district will participate by providing age- appropriate instruction focusing on preventing harassment, intimidation, and/or bullying. These lessons and activities will be taught in the classroom by the teachers and school counselors.
