We are pleased to announce that the NJ CAP (Child Assault Prevention) program is coming to the Allamuchy Township School District. NJ CAP will be providing training to New Jersey students in grades 2,4,6, and 8.

Trainings will be scheduled on the following dates:

- Monday, March 22: Grade 2
- Tuesday, March 23: Grade 3
- Wednesday and Thursday, March 24 and 25: Grades 6 and 8
- Friday, March 26: Grade 8

Due to the length of NJCAP's Teen CAP Program, 8th Grade will have 3-1 hour sessions span across 3 three days.

NJ CAP student training will focus on teaching students about bullying prevention, being assertive without aggression, self-protection strategies, and more.

NJ CAP facilitators will also be training staff as well as inviting parents to attend a parental presentation on **March 17, 2021 at 6pm via Zoom.** Parents can participate and understand what their children will learn inside the virtual classroom. All parents and guardians are welcomed to attend.
