Allamuchy Township School's Notable Achievements & Comments

- In Language Arts, all grades showed an increased percentage of proficiency
- 80% proficiency rate in Algebra 1 (35% was the state average)
- More than 50% were proficient in math in 3rd grade (about 10 percentage points above the state average)
- 2 New Series/Programs
 - Big Ideas- Math K-5 2nd Year of Program
 - Fountas & Pinnell ELA Program NEW 2021-2022

Intervention Strategies

- Continued targeted ASIP instruction at all grade levels
- Math advisor time at ATS with focus on 6-8 intervention
- Basic skills instruction and sessions with Reading Specialist through RTI program
- Increase in small group instruction for ELL students, daily
- High Impact Tutoring through the State Grant Program. This will provide intensive instruction in language arts and math and have a focus on assisting our current 3, 4, and some 5 grade students.

New Jersey Student Learning Assessment – Science (NJSLA-Science)

The NJSLA-Science:

- Is a federally required state assessment administered to students in grades 5, 8, and 11
- Provides a snapshot of student performance on the New Jersey Student Learning Standards for Science (NJSLS-Science).
- Was developed in collaboration with NJ educators, the New Jersey Department of Education (NJDOE), and New Jersey's contracted science vendors
- Is significantly different from the New Jersey Assessment of Skills and Knowledge (NJ ASK) because NJSLS-Science are more rigorous standards and NJSLA-Science focuses on the application of science knowledge and skills rather than memorization of content.
