# Notable Achievements

- Increase of 7<sup>th</sup> & 8<sup>th</sup> grade students exceeding expectations!
  - 42% Exceeded expectations in last year's 8<sup>th</sup> grade class in ELA.
- 82% of Algebra I students MET or EXCEEDED expectations.
- 78% of Grade 8 ELA students MET or EXCEEDED expectations.
- Cohort of same students, consecutive grades show growth over time throughout middle school.



# INTERVENTION STRATEGIES & DATA REFLECTION

- \* Parents received student test reports in September
- \* Link It! Benchmark Assessments grades 2-8 (3 times a year)
- \* Chromebook carts down to 3<sup>rd</sup> grade (per homeroom) & added cart for MVS 2<sup>nd</sup> grade to share
- \* ATS teachers utilize Professional Learning Community (PLC) time to analyze data to prepare and adjust the scope and sequence of our curriculum
- \* MVS PLC time to focus on teaching writing
- \* Teacher committees will be created to review our Math and ELA Series this year
- \* Continued Basic Skills Instructor to provide support to students in need
