# I. Essentials for Class Each Day

#### Pencils/Eraser

Notebook – Spiral (1, 3 or 5 Subject)or Binder with loose leaf paper (your choice on what works best for you)

Folder to keep homework, tests and quizzes

#### **Tests and Quizzes**

• Tests will be given after each chapter and quizzes will be given frequently to check for understanding of concepts.

# III. Homework

- Homework is an activity designed to supplement class work. It provides the student with the opportunity to practice and reinforce skills on an individual basis and therefore will be assigned each day.
- Homework will be posted in the classroom.
- Homework will be checked the following day. Homework will be checked to ensure that it is completely done. For work to be considered completework must be shown and every problem must be attempted.
- Homework can be handed in late but 10 points will be deducted each day it is late. Homework will not be accepted after 3 days late unless previously discussed with the teacher.
- After remediation, homework may be corrected on a separate piece of loose leaf paper and resubmitted for additional points.
- Copying someone else's homework is considered cheating and will be dealt with according to the student code of conduct.
