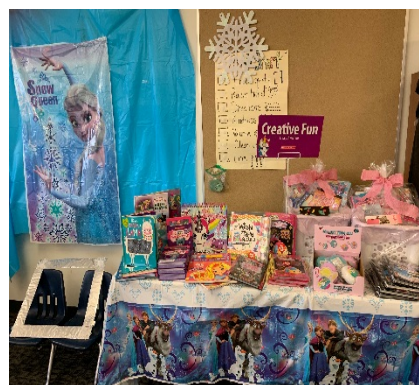

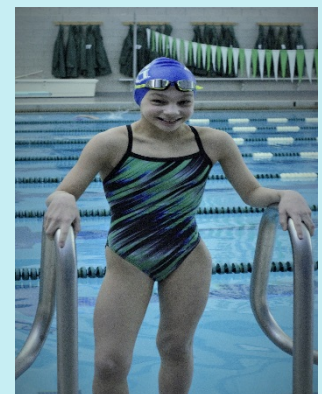
Township School

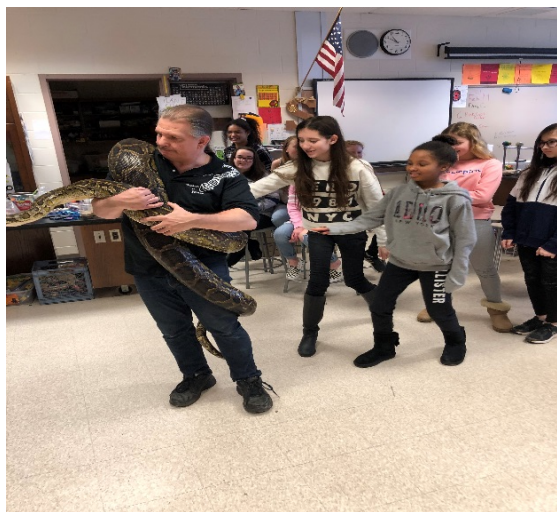
GABRIELLA CEFALONI -2019 JUNIOR OLYMPIAN

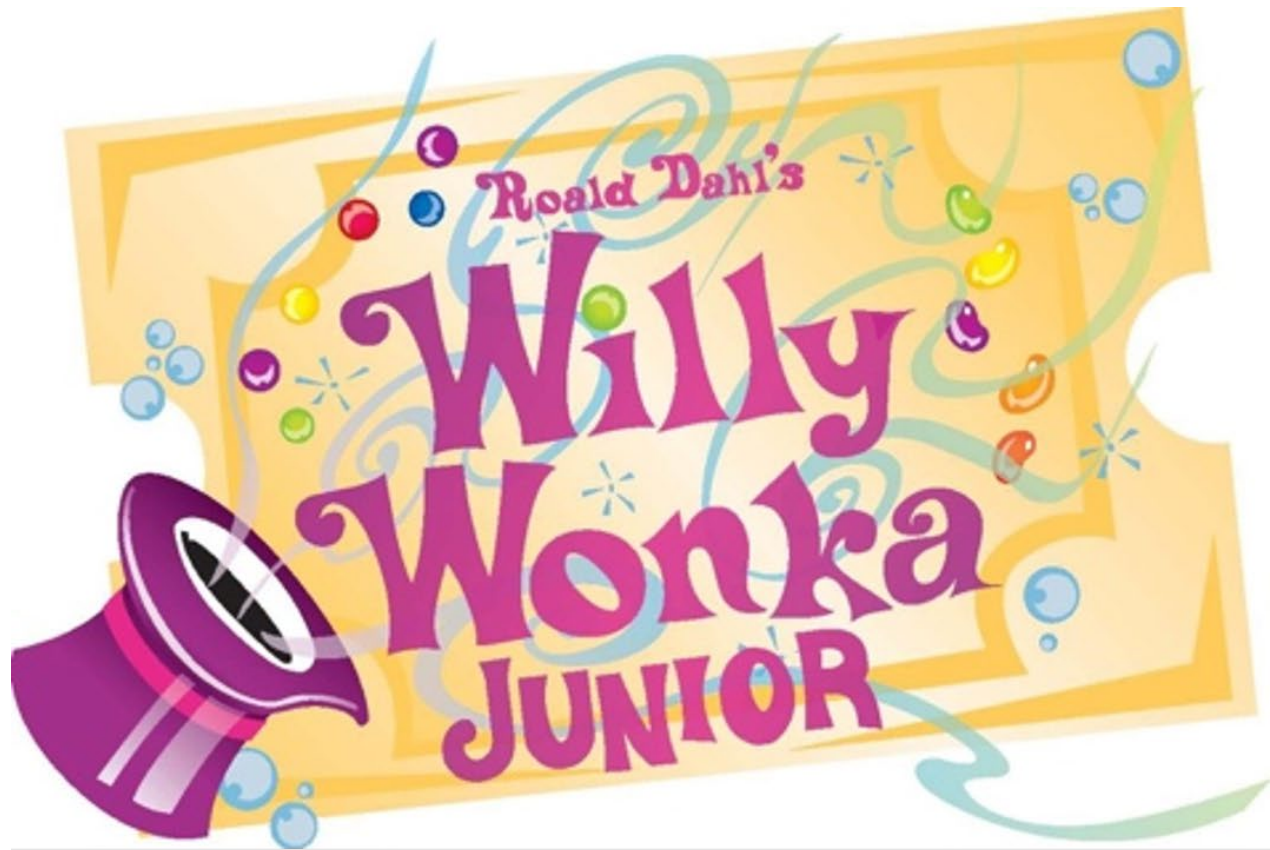
