Dear Parents and Guardians,

Just a reminder that we will continue with fully-virtual learning from November 30 to December 11 following our 9-period-abbreviated schedule which can be found here. During these two weeks, the district will continue to evaluate public health data and recommendations from our local health department and plan for a return to in-person instruction accordingly. Our aim continues to return to the in-person hybrid model on December 14 as long as the data indicates that this is an appropriate course of action. This decision will be made and communicated by December 11. Our region continues to remain in the "High Risk" (Orange) category on the New Jersey Department of Health COVID-19 Regional Risk Matrix. Please see the chart below for details on the high risk category as it relates to contact tracing:
