



Incoming 6th Grade Summer Reading Assignment 2020

For your Summer Reading Assignment you will need to pick 2 **books to read; one for July and one for August**. The books can be either fiction or nonfiction. Each book will have a separate assignment that will need to be completed. The July one will be completed at home and is due the first day of school and the August one will be completed in school during the first few days of school. **The only criteria we have for your book choice is that it has to be at least 5 AR points and it may NOT be a book that has been made into a movie.** You can use the following link to check the points of your book: arbookfind.com. If you are not sure if it has been made into a movie please do a search on-line.

July Book For the July book you will need to complete the following assignment. This assignment will need to be handed in on the first day of school and will be graded. For the July assignment you will need to identify and record at least 10 significant quotes from the book (see attached organizer as a guide). Each entry should include a quote (at least 2-3 sentences), the page number on which it is found, and a 3-4 sentence analysis of why the quote is significant. For example, the quote might capture a key moment within the plot, reveal the personality of a major character, include well-crafted figurative language or important symbolism, or may inspire thought or have a personal connection to your own life.. Whatever the reason, explain why the quote matters and/or your reason for selecting it. The quotations should be kept in the order in which they appear in the book.

August Book The August book will need to be read by the first day of school and you will complete an assignment on that book on the first day of school. This will also be graded
