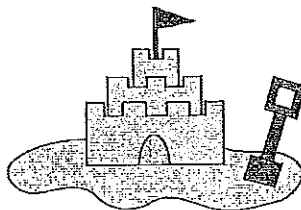
## Summer Packet

- ❖ Practice reading & writing Kindergarten high frequency sight words.

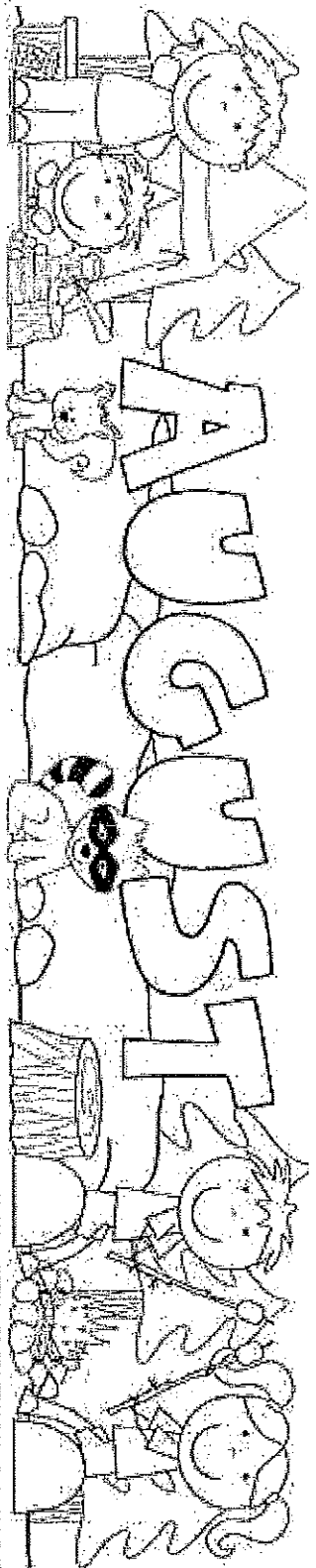
